
## Highlights of the year:

- 5- The deteriorating situation of refugee camps in northern Syria.




## **Projects according to clusters:**

### Food Security Cluster:

• This cluster had the biggest share of this year's projects, with 67% of all projects and number of 84 projects, the largest of which was in the Eastern Ghouta in response to the fast deteriorating situation in the first quarter of the year.




#### **Protection Cluster:**
